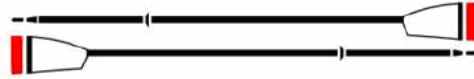

PART TIME AND ASSISTANT COACHING POSITIONS:

Club crew coach - 4-6 hrs/week

We have club/recreational crews rowing in the evenings Monday-Thursday and weekend mornings with skills ranging from beginner to intermediate. We also offer small boat sculling clinics to rowers of all skill levels. US Rowing Level I Coaching Certification preferred. Good communication skills and a positive and encouraging attitude a must. Must be able to respond to a broad range of skill levels and goals. \$10-15 hourly stipend.

Junior Novice Coach (two positions available) – 12hrs/week on the water plus some administrative support of IRC junior program. The novice coach is responsible for leading the volunteer instructors during the classes, promoting safety and fun in rowing, and instructing rowing technique. This program meets 4-5 times per week 4:30-6:30PM and focuses on technique and helps build confidence on the water. Fall season runs August 20th- November 1: spring season is March 1 - mid May. Good communication skills and a positive and encouraging attitude a must. Seasonal stipend based on experience.

Assistant Juniors Coach (two positions available) – 10 hrs/week

IRC is seeking two assistant coaches to work with our Head Junior Boy/Girl Coach during the junior season August 15- November 1 and March 1- mid May. Responsibilities include implementing training plans, assisting in organizing practices, selecting lineups and traveling to regattas with crews. Supervising loading and unloading of the trailer and overseeing that the equipment is maintained, and safety guidelines upheld. Seasonal stipend based on experience.

These positions may require a criminal background check.

Compensation based on experience. Opportunities for additional compensation through private lessons are available.
