The Scholarship Committee makes awards based upon financial need, positive attitude and active volunteer participation. To stretch scholarship funds as far as possible, the Committee gives preference to applications for partial awards. Failure to participate in rowing activities for which the scholarship applies will result in ineligibility for future scholarship awards. Scholarships will be awarded only to the extent that funds are available.
