The Indianapolis Rowing Center's Mission is to develop youth and adults of all social and economic backgrounds through the sport of rowing by providing experienced and knowledgeable instruction, a variety of skill-enhancing programs and world-class facilities.

Eligibility: All current or future members/juniors of the Indianapolis Rowing Center (IRC) are eligible for a partial or full fee award for participation in IRC Membership, Programs or Classes. Previous rowing experience or Indianapolis residency is not required.

Application: The application is confidential, and will be reviewed only by the Fund Development Committee. This Committee makes awards based upon financial need, positive attitude and active volunteer participation. Failure to participate in rowing activities for which the assistance applies will result in ineligibility for future awards. Financial assistance will be awarded only to the extent that funds are available.

Obligations: If awarded, there are obligations in exchange for the assistance. These include:

- a positive and respectful attitude towards IRC and the membership
- attending all practices and regattas (Juniors)
- representing IRC in a mature fashion during community events or regattas
- 8 additional volunteer hours to IRC
- return a signed copy of the acceptance letter to the Executive Director
